The first chapter of my book is called ‘The White Swan’ because these events are predictable. *But generation after generation, we seem to forget the past.* When there's a bubble, there's euphoria. There's irrational exuberance. Consumers can use their homes like ATM machines. Governments and policymakers are happy because they get reelected. Wall Street makes billions of dollars of profits.
