- **FAQ about Gabriel**
  - NAME: “[strong] \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb: *geber* and *El*)
  - POSITION: “I stand in the \_\_\_\_\_.” (Luke 1:19)
    - Ezekiel 28:14—“ . . . a \_\_\_\_\_ cherub on the holy mount of God, among the fiery stones”
    - Exodus 25:22—“ . . . the mercy seat [God’s \_\_\_\_\_] between the two cherubim
    - Ezekiel 28:15, 16—\_\_\_\_\_ was one of the two guardian cherubim (see also Isaiah 14:12-14).
    - Because of Gabriel’s role in sacred history as the divine emissary to earth, it is clear he \_\_\_\_\_ the fallen Lucifer.
  - RANK: Next to \_\_\_\_\_ (Revelation 1:1; Daniel 10:13)
  - INCARNATION ASSIGNMENT: Jesus’ personal \_\_\_\_\_ angel
  
- **Gabriel and Mary (Luke 1:26-38)**
  - Luke 1:37 NIV 2011—“For no word from God will ever \_\_\_\_\_.”
  - Luke 1:37 NKJV—“For with God \_\_\_\_\_ will be impossible.”
  - Genesis 18:14—“Is anything too hard for the LORD?” (In the Greek these are the same words Gabriel spoke to Mary.
  
- **Gabriel and Mary and You**
  - “No word from God will ever fail.” (Luke 1:37)
    - Malachi 3:10
    - A young adult’s testimony  
“As the Giver of every blessing, God claims a certain portion of all we possess. This is His provision to sustain the preaching of the gospel. And by making this return to God, we are to show our appreciation of His gifts. . . . All His gifts are promised on condition of obedience. God has a heaven full of blessings for those who will co-operate with Him. All who obey Him may with confidence claim the fulfillment of His promises.” (*Christ’s Object Lessons* 144, 145)
  - “The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you.” (Luke 1:35)
    - “The lapse of time has wrought no change in Christ’s parting promise to send the Holy Spirit as His representative. It is not because of any restriction on the part of God that the riches of His grace do not flow earthward to men. If the fulfillment of the promise is not seen as it might be, it is because the promise is not appreciated as it should be. If all were \_\_\_\_\_, all would be filled with the Spirit. Wherever the need of the Holy Spirit is a matter little thought of, there is seen spiritual drought, spiritual darkness, spiritual declension and death. Whenever minor matters occupy the attention, the divine power which is necessary for the growth and prosperity of the church, and which would bring all other blessings in its train, is lacking, though offered in infinite plenitude.” (*Acts of the Apostles* 50)
    - Ron Clouzet: “The Holy Spirit is still at work in the church. He has never left us. He works today through scores of faithful believers, and He will continue to do so. But He wants to \_\_\_\_\_.” (*Adventism’s Greatest Need: The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit* 68)
