 - J. I. Packer, *Keep in Step with the Spirit: Finding Fullness in Our Walk with God*: “The Spirit’s message to us is never ‘Look at me; listen to me; come to me; get to know me’ but always ‘Look at *Him*, and see His glory; listen to *Him*, and hear His word; go to *Him*, and have life; get to know *Him*, and taste His gift of joy and peace.’ The Spirit, we might say, is the matchmaker, the celestial marriage broker, whose role it is to bring us and Christ together and ensure that we _____ together.” (Quoted in Frank Hasel, “The Holy Spirit and Spirituality,” Jan-Mar 2017 SS Study Guide p 18)
 - *Desire of Ages*: “The Holy Spirit is Christ’s representative, but divested of the personality of humanity, and independent thereof. Cumbered with humanity, Christ could not be in every place personally. Therefore it was for their interest that He should go to the Father, and send the Spirit to be His successor on earth. No one could then have any advantage because of his location or his personal contact with Christ. By the Spirit the Saviour would be accessible to all. In this sense He would be _____ to them than if He had not ascended on high.” (669)

- Luke 11:5-8—Because it’s only when we realize we have _____ that we are ripe and ready for the _____ God has for us.
- Luke 11:8—“. . . yet because of your _____ he will surely get up and give you as much as you _____.”
- Luke 11:9-13
 - *Desire of Ages*: “This promised blessing [the Holy Spirit], claimed by faith, brings _____ other blessings in its train. It is given according to the riches of the grace of Christ, and He is ready to supply every soul according to the capacity to receive.” (672)
 - Ellen White: “With the reception of this gift [the Holy Spirit], _____ other gifts would be ours; for we are to have this gift according to the plentitude of the riches of the grace of Christ, and He is ready to supply every soul according to the capacity to receive.” (*Ye Shall Receive Power* 221)
- Luke 11:13—“. . . how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who [keep on asking/_____] ask Him.”
 - Ellen White: “Morning by morning [Jesus] communicated with His Father in heaven, receiving from Him _____ a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit.” (*Signs of the Times* November 21, 1895)
 - *Acts of the Apostles*: “To the consecrated [follower of Jesus] there is wonderful consolation in the knowledge that even Christ during His life on earth sought His Father _____ for fresh supplies of needed grace.” (56)
 - *Christ’s Object Lessons*: “Our prayers are to be as earnest and persistent as was the petition of the needy friend who asked for the loaves at midnight. The more earnestly and steadfastly we ask, the _____ will be our spiritual union with Christ.” (146)
