	•	The of the Testimony was the most critical piece of sanctuary furniture on the Day of Atonement—or <i>Yom Kippur</i> .
		■ Leviticus 16 describes the Day of Atonement as a of the sanctuary (vv 16, 30).
		It was a liturgical day symbolizing God's final on sin at the end of time through the sacrifice of Christ.

- Daniel 8:14 places that judgment in the stream of time.
  - Daniel prophesies a Day of Atonement judgment—a cleansing-ofthe-records judgment in heaven's sanctuary above.
  - Daniel 7:9, 10 describes that judgment.
  - Today's urgent message to the world: "Fear God and give glory to him, for the hour of his judgment is come. And worship him that made heaven and earth, the sea and the fountains of waters." (Revelation 14:7)
  - Do you know that Revelation 7:1-4 and 11:18, 19 describe \_\_\_\_\_ natural disaster catastrophes that will occur as the heavenly sanctuary judgment draws to an end before Jesus returns?
  - Are we nearing the end of the heavenly judgment?
  - "See the storms and tempests. . . . and here we are dependent upon God for our lives—our present and eternal life. And being in the position that we are, we need to be wide awake, wholly devoted, wholly converted, wholly consecrated to God. But we seem to sit as though we were paralyzed. God of heaven, wake us up!" (2SM 52)
- That's why this "Daniel 8:14 prayer" of Hezekiah's is a prayer for this generation that clings to faith in the promise of Christ!
