□ **THE LAMB**

- For this one \_\_\_\_\_ John the Baptist was born.
- For this one \_\_\_\_\_ you and I have been born.
- “ \_\_\_\_\_, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” (v 29 NIV)
  - Isaiah 53:4-7
  - “Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” is essentially the cry, “Behold, the \_\_\_\_\_ of the world!”
- Robert Smith: “By means of this first utterance of Jesus, the evangelist poses a question to all readers of the gospel. As we approach the Jesus who inhabits the pages of the Fourth Gospel, the evangelist insists that we not rush forward, mindlessly turning pages. He wants us to stop and take to heart this question, ‘What are you \_\_\_\_\_?’ What do you want from this Jesus? What are you hoping for and looking for as you read the story of Jesus set forth in this gospel? What are you seeking with all of your striving and working and thinking? What is the target and goal of all your living?” (*Wounded Lord* 23)
- *Desire of Ages*: “[Jesus] does not tell to any all that He might reveal, but He bids every trembling soul take courage.” (568)
- *Steps to Christ*: “No sooner does one come to Christ than there is born in his heart a desire to make known to others what a precious \_\_\_\_\_ he has found in Jesus; the saving and sanctifying truth cannot be shut up in his heart. . . . [W]e shall not be able to hold our \_\_\_\_\_. If we have tasted and seen that the Lord is good, we shall have something to tell. Like Philip when he found the Saviour, we shall invite others into His presence. We shall seek to present to them the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ and the unseen realities of the world to come. . . . There will be an earnest longing that those around us may ‘behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.’ John 1:29.” (78, 79)

  - #5—Do not \_\_\_\_\_.
  - #6—Invite personal \_\_\_\_\_: “Come and see.”
  - #7—\_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus.

- *Steps to Christ* again: “And the effort to bless others will react in \_\_\_\_\_ upon ourselves. This was the purpose of God in giving us a part to act in the plan of redemption. He has granted men the privilege of becoming partakers of the divine nature and, in their turn, of diffusing blessings to their fellow men. This is the highest honor, the greatest joy, that it is possible for God to bestow upon men. Those who thus become participants in labors of love are brought \_\_\_\_\_ to their Creator. . . . [I]n His infinite love He chose to make us co-workers with Himself, with Christ and the angels, that we might share the blessing, the joy, the spiritual uplifting, which results from this unselfish ministry. . . . And it is only as we thus fulfill the divine purpose in our creation, that life can be a blessing to us.” (79, 80)
