 - Matthew 11:7, 10—“Jesus began to say to the multitudes concerning John [the Baptist]: ‘. . . This is he of whom it is written: “Behold, I send My _____ [*angellos*] before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You.”’”

- John T. Anderson: “When we examine the Scriptures, it becomes clear that _____ is the highest form of worship, and that without it all worship is meaningless.” (*Three Angels, One Message* 113)
 - “At the name of Jehovah angels fold their wings. . . . Worship styles today often reflect a similar casualness, with worship teams dressing in attire more appropriate for the beach than for the house of the Lord. This attempt to ‘bring God down to us’ does not reflect the honor and respect that the Sovereign of the universe is due. Worship does not bring Him *down* to us—it raises us *up* to Him. Should worshippers today confront the awesome majesty of the divine, they would make haste to cover their faces and repent of their cavalier demeanor.” (59, 60)
 - “The biblical summons to worship ‘Him who made,’ the Creator-God, must include a call to return to the keeping of the seventh-day Sabbath. . . . Instituted at Creation, it is embedded in the Ten Commandments written by God’s own finger. In an age that presents evolution as the explanation of how life began, there is to be a clear and decisive appeal to return to the

- understanding of God as Creator and to observe the only day that Scripture identifies as being sanctified and blessed—His memorial of creatorship, the seventh-day Sabbath.” (21)
- David Wells, *The Courage to Be Protestant*: “The born-again, marketing church has calculated that unless it makes deep, serious cultural adaptations, it will go out of business, especially with the younger generations.
