## » Invitation #1–Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ invitation.

- Ralph Carmichael: “The Savior is waiting to enter your heart—why don’t you let Him come in? There’s nothing in this world to keep you apart—what is your answer to Him?”
- Proverbs 23:26—“My child, give Me your \_\_\_\_\_ .”
- John 14:23—“Anyone who loves Me will obey My teaching. My Father will love them, and We will come to them and make Our \_\_\_\_\_ with them.”
- John 14:17—“The Spirit of Truth \_\_\_\_\_ with you and will be in you.”
- Ellen White: “That heart is the happiest that has Christ as an abiding \_\_\_\_\_ . . . . Let us acknowledge Him as our Friend and Saviour.” (*My Life Today* 157)

## » Invitation #2–Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ invitation.

- Mark 13:26, 29 NASB: “Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. . . . Even so, you too, when you see these things happening, recognize that He is near, right at the \_\_\_\_\_ .”
- Revelation 22:12, 20: “Look! I am coming \_\_\_\_\_ ! . . . He who testifies to these things says, ‘Yes, I am coming \_\_\_\_\_ ‘”

## » Invitation #3–Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ invitation.

- Ellen White: “The Holy Spirit waits to soften and subdue hearts; but they are not willing to open

the door and let the Saviour in, for fear that He will require something of them. And so Jesus of Nazareth passes by. He longs to bestow on them the rich blessings of His grace, but they refuse to accept them. What a terrible thing it is to exclude Christ from His own temple! What a \_\_\_\_\_ to the church!" (*Testimonies to the Church* 6:262)

- Song of Solomon: "[She speaks] I slept but my heart was awake. Listen! My lover is knocking: '[He speaks] Open to me, my sister, my darling, my dove, my flawless one. My head is drenched with dew, my hair with the dampness of the night.' [She] I have taken off my robe—must I put it on again? I have washed my feet—must I soil them again? My lover thrust his hand through the latch-opening; my heart began to pound for him. I arose to open for my lover . . ." (Song of Solomon 5:2-5).
- Sigve Tonstad: "... to this thoroughly unlikeable community, Jesus propositions a privilege so amazing that I don't dare repeat it (3:20-21)."
