MUSIC ALIVE

" OF FOUNDATIONS"

This exploration touches upon two very different uses of "foundation." First, for the hymn "The Church Has One Foundation" we mix-and-match the words of hymn 348 with the melody of 619. A hymnal resource, the metrical tune index (p. 819), yielded a potential match for these two through the fact that the melodies of both 348 and 619 have the meter "7.6.7.6.D." The numbers indicate successive syllables in poetic lines and

"D." indicates that that meter occurs twice while going through the melody once. What other 7.6.7.6.D. melodies (pp. 820-821) may be good matches for the words of 348? The other "foundations" include those used in today's Opening Voluntary. "Foundations" (French fonds) are a major portion of the organ's tonal palette. Fonds form all the tones for today's Opening Voluntary.




