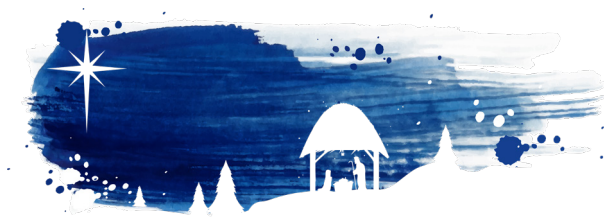
CALL TO WORSHIP
