Pioneer Piloting Alive in Jesus Children's Sabbath School Curriculum

Our Kindergarten 5-6 Year, Primary Grade 3, and Junior Grade 5 Sabbath Schools are leading our pilot, fully implementing, with parents and our volunteer teams providing research feedback.
