## **Beds for Berrien**

On April 16, Pioneer is planning to provide beds for children in our community who don't have any. This project needs your help! There are 3 main ways to assist: First, you can donate. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 to provide 40 beds to children who need a better sleeping situation in their homes. Your donations to the Pioneer Outreach fund will help us reach that goal! Second, we need volunteers who can help us get organized on our bed distribution day. We'll be unloading bed frames, mattresses, and bedding, sorting them into piles, and loading them into delivery vehicles. Third, we need 40 delivery teams to transport the beds and bedding to homes, and assemble the bed frames for the families.
