MICHIGAN ADVANCE PARTNERS

The congregation in Big Rapids knew their church roof needed to be replaced but had no idea how to pay for it. Buckets had to be placed in the hallway when it rained in order to catch the water coming in—and each time it rained, there was potential for further damage to walls and floors. Estimates for having the roof replaced came to over \$20,000! For a small group of 20-30 people, it looked as if the church would have to go into debt to pay for the necessary roof replacement. With many prayers for guidance and asking God to provide the necessary funds, the Big Rapids church submitted an application to MAP requesting financial assistance to repair the church roof. The news that MAP would be able to pay approximately half the cost of the repairs brought great relief to the congregation. When available local funds were combined with the money donated by MAP, the church was able to pay for the needed repairs without incurring any debt! The members in Big Rapids are worshipping again with no worry for the rain or snowand with gratitude for God's provision through Michigan Advance Partners.
