CALL TO WORSHIP

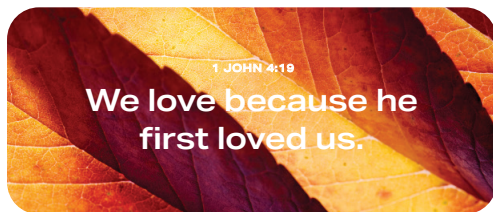
Pastor: Sing praises to the Lord, for he has done marvelous things!

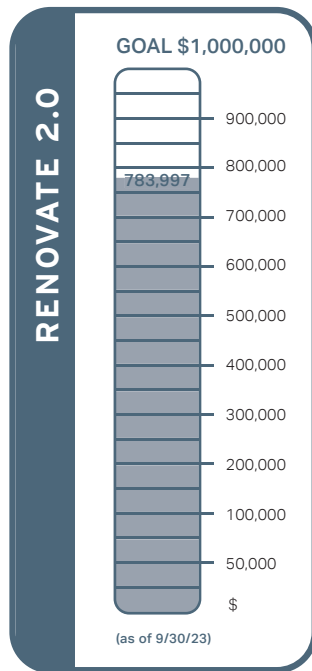
