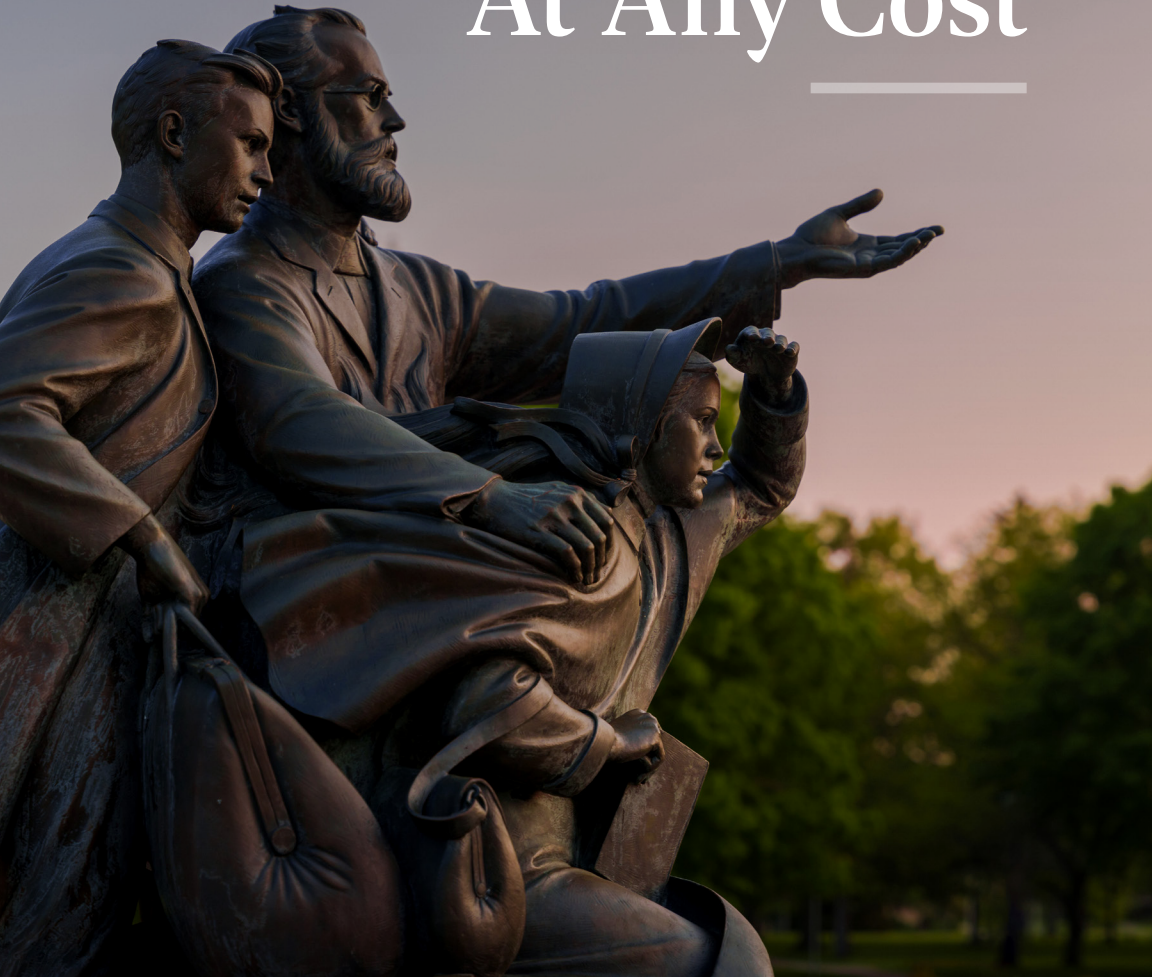

Dr. Jo Ann Davidson and Minister of Music Kenneth Logan will lead, closing at sundown.



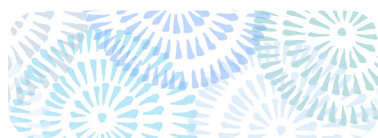
