

Safety Sabbath

MARCH 29

Every day, around 2,300 children are reported missing in the USA. At Pioneer, we prioritize child safety and have procedures to swiftly locate missing minors. Over the past two years, our efforts have successfully reunited missing children with their quardians, thanks to our dedicated volunteers. On March 29, 2025, we will participate in Adventist Risk Management's Safety Sabbath by conducting a Missing Child drill between 10:00 and 10:30 AM. During this time, a child will be reported missing as part of the drill. Please remain calm: this is only a practice exercise. We encourage everyone to be alert for the child described. If you see a child matching the description, please notify any volunteer with a badge (Deacon, Greeter, or Sabbath School teacher). Thank you for helping us keep Pioneer safe.
