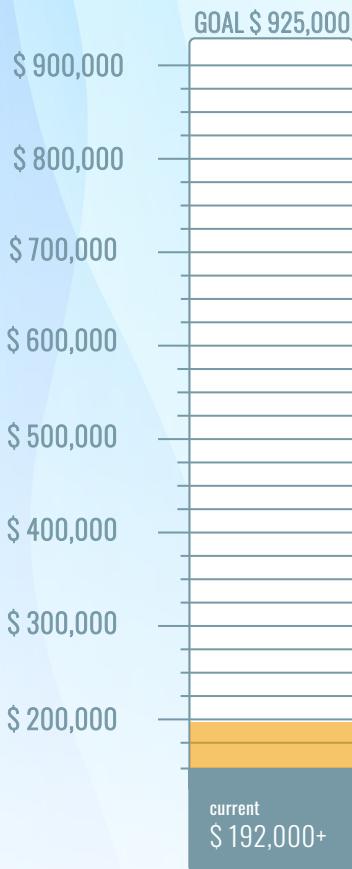
## MICRO-TOUR OF RENOVATED PIPES
