
## PROJECT UPDATE

The new pipes are either steel or copper, but not the cheaper PVC pipe. Why? One, while PVC pipe is hard at room temperature, it softens in hot water. And two, the combination of high and low pressure cycles along with heat and cold cycles causes the PVC to become brittle. PVC would fail long before steel and copper. The re-piping project makes PMC a welcoming place for decades to come. Please support this great need!
