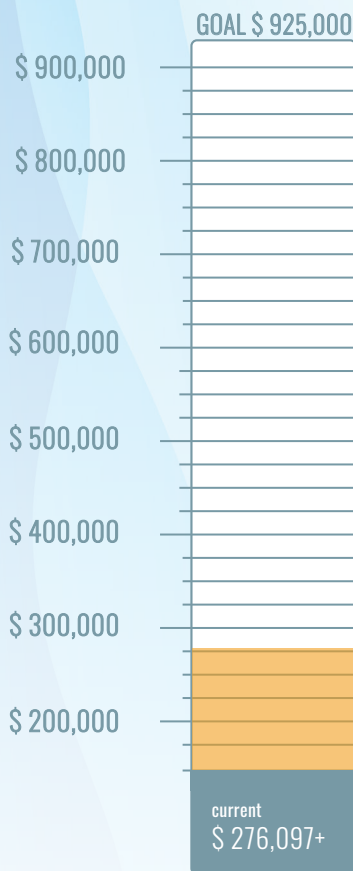
PROGRESS & GRATITUDE

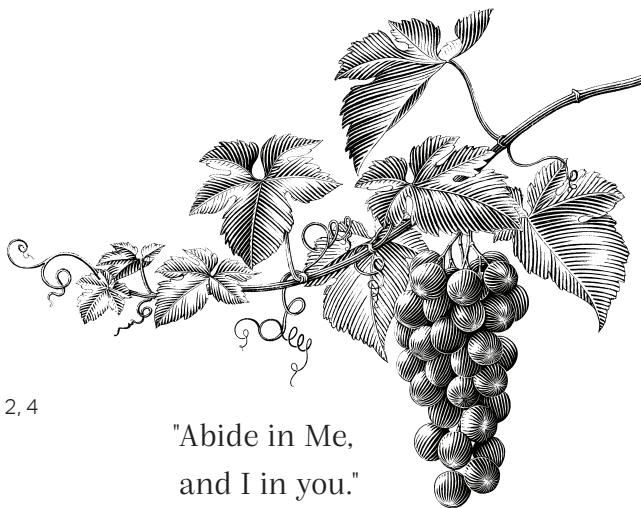
