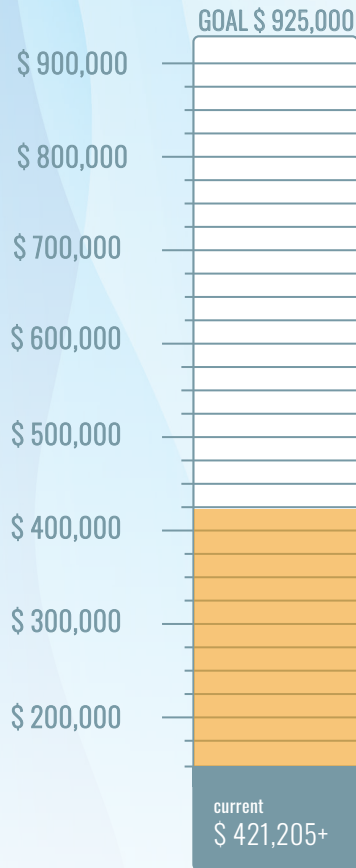
PASSION PLAY
