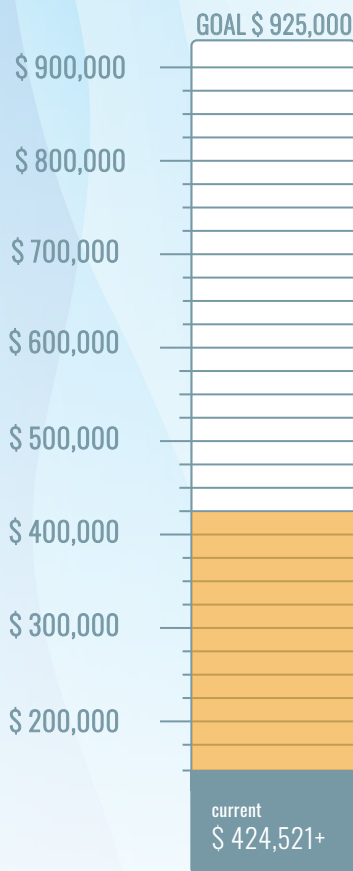

With This in Mind . . .

The lack of sleep is not something to brag about. It certainly is not an indicator of being more dedicated. Adequate sleep is needed to help with concentration, decision-making,

remembering as well as problem solving. The Journal of Occupational Environmental Medicine (Williamson & Feyer, 2000) published that after 17-19 hours without sleep, participants were as alert as someone with a 0.005 blood alcohol level. With a longer gap, the more at risk an individual becomes, and perhaps should not even be driving! Be temperate in all things (1 Cor. 9:25). Prioritize and get sufficient sleep.
