With This In Mind . . .

Although painful and disruptive, loss is an inevitable part of life. If you—or someone you know—has experienced a significant loss, allow time to engage in the tasks of mourning (Worden, 1982). There is no need to rush. Grief may include changes in appetite, sleep disturbance, social withdrawal, numbness, or “brain fog”—these are normal. While therapy or support groups are not required, they can help when grief becomes prolonged or disruptive. Be patient with yourself and others; compassion goes a long way. (See 2 Cor. 1:3–4.)
