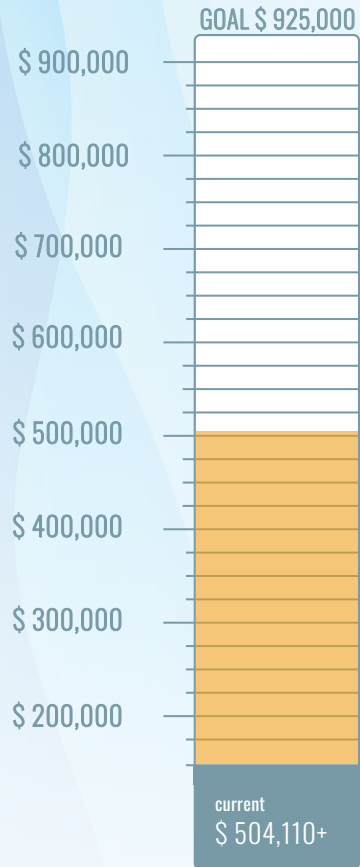

If someone discloses to you this intent, these referrals are useful: 1) Dial or text 988 in the U.S. and Canada to connect with the Suicide & Crisis Lifeline (includes Spanish), 2) Text TALK to 741-741 to connect with a crisis counselor, and 3) For veterans, dial 988 and press 1, or text 838255.
